What will you be doing?

A Support Worker role is varied however may involve assisting with personal care and daily living including personal care and hygiene, social support, domestic assistance including cleaning, shopping and meal preparation and community participation.

A Support Worker builds a positive and supportive relationship with the person they support, enabling the person to reach their goals and be actively involved in the community. This may require assistance with mobility using hoist and communication devices.
